Report on the Audit of Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying statement of annual financial results of Sanathnagar Enterprises Limited (hereinafter referred to as 'the Company') for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2023 ('the Statement'), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ('Listing Regulations').

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## NOTES TO THE AUDITED FINANCIAL RESULTS

- The audited financial results of Sanathnagar Enterprises Limited ("the Company") for the quarter and year ended 31-March-23 have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on 12-April-23. The financial results for the quarter and year ended 31-March-23 have been audited by the Statutory Auditor of the Company who have expressed an unmodified opinion.
- 2 Disclosure under Ind AS 108 on 'Operating Segment' is not applicable as the Company has only one reportable segment which is real estate development.
- 3 The Company had applied to BSE Limited (where its shares are listed), for approving a Scheme of merger by absorption of the Company with Macrotech Developers Limited, the holding company, pursuant to approval granted by Board of Directors of the Company, at its meeting held on 25-January-2022. As more than a year has elapsed from the filing of the Scheme, the Company will take fresh approvals as applicable for the merger.
- 4 The figures for the quarter ended 31-March-23 and 31-March-22 represents the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the reviewed published year-to-date figures upto the third quarter of the respective financial year.
- 5 The previous period's/ year's figures have been regrouped, re-arranged and reclassified wherever necessary to conform to current period's presentation.
